Dear Friend of Horsetown-Clear Creek Preserve,

The Preserve trails damaged by the Clover Fire continue to be a challenge to maintain for our regular group of volunteers. Please come out and help with this on Saturday March 25 starting at 9 a.m. (rain date Tuesday March 28). Our group will operate chain saws and weed whackers while volunteers work with hand tools such as mcleods, shovels, rakes, hoes, loppers and clippers. Please bring these hand tools if you can and we will bring extras for those who cannot. This will be our first event this spring. Our last event will be picking up trash along Clear Creek Road on Saturday, June 17 at 9 a.m. – another volunteer opportunity. See more on our list of events.

In between these “working events” we have planned several popular hikes for your pleasure enjoy some easy to moderate nature walks with sunshine, fresh air and a beautiful creek. Each event leader is knowledgeable about the topic, presents interesting information, and answers your questions.

The Preserve is also seeking new members for our Board of Directors. Non-profits are required to operate through a board. This is a wonderful opportunity to be involved but does not require a large time commitment. We are also looking for volunteers for quarterly adopt-a-highway cleanup on Clear Creek Road near the Preserve, and volunteers to help with trail maintenance as needed.

In January we attended the second series of public meetings with BLM as they collected information for their new Resource Management Plan which will be effective for the next 15 – 20 years. We were involved in this process in the early 1990’s advocating for restoration of public lands, improving salmon spawning, and more trails along lower Clear Creek. We hope you have enjoyed the many new BLM trails, access to the creek around us and spawning salmon.
