We had the California Conservation Corp do some fire mitigation work at the Preserve early this year. They cut and stacked down fuels for small pile burns. Volunteers also helped the Board with small pile burns and an Adopt-a-Highway cleanup along a two-mile stretch on Clear Creek Road near the Preserve.
